Located in the Alentejo zone in the south of Portugal, Roquevale specializes in local varietals made into classically styled wines. From perhaps the country's greatest woman winemaker, Joana Roque du Val, these vines are just minutes from the sea, and have ideal climactic conditions for growing wines of expression, power, and nuance. Although Roquevale is a larger-sized estate, Joana crafts wines from individual crus, making small batches as unique from one another as snowflakes. "I believe that every hill tastes different," says Joana. "For other foods, location matters less. But for wine, it is the most important thing, maybe everything – because place determines the grape, the ripeness, the acidity, the character, everything. A winemaker must have an acute sensitivity to place – if not, we are not making wine. We are making something else." And what a place she has! With large chunks of schist rock, it is reminiscent of Porto, or even Priorat in Spain, two appellations with world-famous, distinct winemaking terrain. For our money, few places are capable of making wines with more character, expression and moxie for the money than Alentejo, Portugal. Just a stiff breeze from Morocco, the south's best wine zone delivers a veritable treasure chest of organoleptic gifts – fragrant prunes, salted almond, pepper jellies and sweet marmalade, and the stinging, bright briny-ness of the warm Mediterranean – all fill your glass, along with delicious, ripe fruit.
